Mauba and Mhlophe are the owners of Gogo-Phenyoga Pub at Jane Furse township in Sekhukhune. They sell alcoholic beverages and roasted meat (braai) from 10h00 to 23h00 on weekends and from 09h 00 to 02h 00 on weekdays. Hundreds of the township residents, including those from the surrounding villages of Phokwane, Gamoloi, Glen Cowie, Madibong, Mamone, Ga-Moretsele and Marishane spend most of their time at the pub. It is also reported that scores of school-going youth from local schools such as Lengamola, Legaletlwana, Rebule are frequently seen at awkward hours drinking there. Many parents are said to have complained to the local government authorities that the existence of the Gogo-Phenyoga Pub in the township has drastically affected the performance of the learners at the local schools. However, Mauba and Mhlophe have consistently rejected these claims. Recently, a fight broke out between two young men which resulted in the death of one of the patrons and a serious injury to a 17-year-old girl, Sesfikile, who was described as one of the regular faces at the pub. It is alleged that the two men had been fighting over the injured girl. The girl's father, Paepae Kadijela, confronted the pub owners about the incident, accusing them of encouraging "under-age" youth to drink liquor. The argument resulted in a physical scuffle involving Paepae, Mauba

pub owners about the incident, accusing them of encouraging "under-age" youth to drink liquor. The argument resulted in a physical scuffle involving Paepae, Mauba and Mhlophe. This led to Mhlophe suffering a severe cut across his face and bruises on his hands. It is said that had it not been for the intervention of one of the vendors near the pub, known to his colleagues as Tsutsuma, the situation would have been worse.

**Mauba and Mhlophe is die eienaars van Gogo-Phenyoga Pub in die Jane Furse township woongebied in Tzaneen. Hulle verkoop alkoholiese drank en braaivleis weksdae vanaf 10h00 tot 23h00. Honderde inwoners van die woongebied asook inwoners van die omliggende woongebiede van Phokwane, Ga-moloi, Glen Cowie, Madibong, Mamone, Ga-Moretsele en Marishane spandeer meeste van hul tyd in die kroeg. Daar is berig dat daar gereeld gesien word dat talle skoolgaande kinders van plaaslike skole soos Lengamola, Legaletwana en Rebule daar drink. Baie ouers het al by die plaaslike owerhede gekla dat die Gogo-Phenyoga pub in die woongebied die kinders se prestasies drasties laat agteruitgaan het. Mauba en Mhlophe het egter die klagtes deurgaans verwerp. 'n Geveg tussen twee jong manne het onlangs die dood van een van die klante veroorsaak en gelei tot die ernstige besering van 'n 17-jarige meisie, Sefikile, wat gereeld by die kroeg te sien was. Daar is beweer dat die mans oor die meisie geveg het. Die meisie se pa, Paepae Kadijela, het die eienaars van die kroeg oor die insident gekonfronteer en hulle beskuldig dat hulle minderjarige jongmense aanmoedig om alkohol te gebruik. Die argument het tot 'n fisiese konfrontasie tussen Paepae, Mauba en Mhlophe gelei. Die gevolg was dat Mhlophe 'n ernstige snywond aan sy gesig opgedoen het en dat sy hande gekneus is. Dit blyk dat indien Tsutsuma, een van die verkopers in die omgewing, nie ingegryp het nie, die situasie veel erger sou gewees het.**

Paepae Kadijela has come to see you (as a legal practitioner) regarding the confrontation he had with the pub owners. He is concerned that the matter will ultimately be brought to a court of law, and he thus wants you to act on his behalf. **Paepae Kadijela het u (as regspraktisyn) kom reedpleeg oor die konfrontasie wat hy met die eienaars van die kroeg gehad het.
